Summary:

Nanyang Technological University's (NTU), Nanyang Business School (NBS) has moved up significantly in the closely-watched annual global MBA rankings by the prestigious The Economist magazine.

This was the best showing yet for NBS, which has been in the world's top 100 MBA list since 2004.

Improved provision of career opportunities for its full-time MBA graduates, and a better alumni network were among the reasons for the school's achievements.

For instance, under the "diversity of recruiters" criterion, it came in fifth globally — indicating the wide spectrum of industries in which graduates can develop their careers, said NBS.
